AN ANALYTICAL STUDY OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURE OF HANDARGULI CATTLE MARKET COMMITTEE (1996-97 TO 2006-07)

Abstract:

Hundarguli Cattle Market is the top most cattle market in Latur district as well as in the Marathwada region of State of Maharashtra. It is commonly known by the name of 'Hali Cattle Market'. 'Hali' and 'Handarguli' these two villages are located on the center of Udgir and Ahmadpur Road. One side of the road is of Hali village and another side of the road is of Hundarguli villege. There is a common bus stop for Halli and Handerguli. The cattle market runs in the area of Hundarguli. Hence, its regulation and management is done by Hundarguli Gram Panchayat Office, Handarguli. Handarguli is 60 kms away from Latur city. It is nearer to Nanded district of Marathwada region and states of Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka. Cattle traders come to this market from other regions of Maharashtra and also from Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Karnataka states of India.

INTRODUCTION-

The special feature of this market is that it runs three days in the week, i.e. Saturday, Sunday and Monday. This market is very popular by the name 'bullock market' especially, Lalkandhari breed of bullock. No entry fee is charged for entering the cattle in the market. Market place is not owned by Handarguli Gram Panchayat, Handarguli. It runs for all months of year but, there is a peek period from Dashara to Gudhi Padwa.

OBJECTIVES OF STUDY:

- 1. To study income pattern of Hundarguli Cattle Market Committee.
- 2. To know expenditure pattern of Hundarguli Cattle Market Committee.
- $3.\,To\,know\,the\,trend\,of\,surplus/\,deficit\,of\,Hundarguli\,Cattle\,Market\,Committee.$

SCOPE & LIMITATION OF STUDY:

The study is limited to Hundarguli Cattle Market Committee only. It covers the period from 1996-97 to 2006-07. It is based on secondary data collected from Hundarguli Gram Panchayat Office, Handarguli.

The Table A discloses the picture of income and expenditure of Handarguli Cattle Market Committee over a period of 11 years i.e. 1996-97 to 2006-07. There is only one source of income i.e.

certificate fee. It is increased from Rs. 1,32,680/- in the year 1996-97 to Rs. 3,69,970/- in the year 2006-07. There is a sudden increase in the year 2003-04. It is because of the certificate fee was charged Rs. 5/- per cattle sold during the period from 1996-97 to 2002-03 and then it is increased to Rs. 10/- per cattle sold since 2003-04. There is an increasing trend over a period of 11 years but, there is no regular increase year by year. The expenditures are classified in three categories. The expenditure on water and lighting facility is considerable high due to increase in electricity rates and shortage in supply. Staff salary is not considerable high. Staff of Handarguli Cattle Market Committee is not permanent in nature and salary is not as per government pay scales. Total expenditures are increased from Rs. 54,520/- in the year 1996-97 to Rs. 76,600/- in the year 2006-07. There is an increasing trend over a period of 11 years, but there is no regular increase year by year.

Handarguli Cattle Market Committee is in surplus continuously over a period of 11 years as its incomes are over than its expenditures. There is mixed trend in surplus till the year 2002-03 and then there is an increasing trend in surplus. The surplus is increased from Rs. 78,160/- in the year 1996-97 to Rs. 2,93,370/- in the year 2006-07.
