Even the huge write up regarding AIDS, in the sense the medication seems to be very less. Even today 80% of the people in the world are unaware of proper information regarding the disease AIDS.? Support of self service organizations to eradicate AIDS:-

Karnataka state AIDS Prevention Society is in the first stage of the National AIDS control project , while Karnataka Health Promotion Trust in the second stage the non-government objective interval programmes are being implemented by KHPT that is to rescue the population that might fix in danger. Though the Government is providing technical and financial assistance, it is being managed systematically by self service organizations through required programmes in between. The main objective of this programme is to provide correct and necessary information to the people who may get infected by AIDS due to their social financial and professional reasons. Also they provide them the necessary items.

Features of the Interval Programme:-

1)Interaction and warm discussions educating the companions, street plays distributions pamphlets, interaction through flash cards exhibition etc, are the tasks carried out to bring out changes in the behaviour.

2)Medication for the infection due to sexual contact and maintenance.

3) Motivate for the usage of Condoms.

4)Creation of good atmosphere.

Though KHPT is alone able to initiate the programmes, it is reach the goal. As unity is very important, the many other organizations should give their helping hands to reach the expected level. After it was declared that though these organizations are not directly involved in the matter related to AIDS, they should provide education regrading the other health problems and the severing of the problems occurred due to HIV/AIDS, many self service organization co-ordinated with KHPT.

Role of NGO: (Important activities autonomous originations)

Guide and suggest the elderly couple to be loyal to their mater.

Educate the teenaged boys and girls about life skills and suggest the youth to involve in sexual contact only after Marriage.

To provide about safety measures, guidelines to those who are in danger including sexual workers and also to render service to the patients.

Moral support and care for those who are living with HIV/AIDS

Healthy interaction and moral support to the widows and pregnant women.

Moral support and care to the orphans.

Progress of net work contacts to receive Government services:-

To inform the patients about the service such as ICTC, PPTCT, and ROT provided by the government to the infections caused due to sexual contact.

To improve the net work contacts so as to ensure the utilization of above services by the focussed group in time to the full extent.

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To reduce the black spot and partial treatment among different groups.

The complete control over positive infection and health care canters:-

To control the positive infection in the people who live with AIDS and establish the health care establishments where ever possible.

These centres work as contact bridges between the facilities available and the focussed groups.

These centres involve friendly discussions, guidance about nutrition's food, moral support, medication for the infection and such other facilities.

The steps taken by the self service organizations to quit the black spot and ill treatment with rasped to AIDS

1)The primary purpose is to provide proper information to the people about HIV/AIDS i.e., its meaning the way it spreads, the way doesn't spread the difference between HIV/AIDS.

2)To make the people get rid of the fear that AIDS is a deadly disease to make everybody know about the fact that the HIV infected could live with a positive altitude for about 10 to 15 years.

3)The feeling that HIV is a problem related to one group must be changed. Any person with his dangerous behaviour may get infected with HIV/AIDS is the matter to be understood by every body.

4)No person will get the HIV/AIDS infection willingly. Due to the pressure of circumstances, knowingly or unknowingly he gets the infection. The society should be informed that such a person must be treated with humanity.

5)To live the life with respect is the right of every one including the HIV/AIDS infected people "It is the duty of everyone to honour the self respect of others ". Our main intension is to convey this message to everyone.

6)All the patients should be treated equally by the caretakers or the nursing staff. It is also the professional ethics. It is not that how the patient got attacked by the disease but it is our duty inferiority complex of the patient and provide him a peaceful atmosphere this reduces the black spot and partiality related the patients disease as well.

7)Separate arrangements should not be made for the HIV/AIDS infected ones in the hospitals, maternity rooms, Wards etc. Treating all the patients equally may reduce the black marks and inequality.

8)Any HIV/AIDS patient could enter the matrimonial life provided the life partner should be aware of the condition of patient and disease as well and after the acceptance it is possible to live a safe and normal life. This message should be conveyed to every one.

9)It is essential not to disclose the "information of the AIDS patients and maintain secret regarding the test reports of HIV/AIDS. It is necessary not to reveal the information of the patient without his/her permission. This helps to wipe out the black mark and inequality.

10) If the patients with HIV positive take part in the AIDS

To observe and cooperate the people who are privileged by the basic service of the contact workers.

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11) The HIV/AIDS positive should be allowed to take part in the fests, functions and communal activities and treated equally. This helps them to increase their mental strength make them to lead an useful life there by enable to be free from black mark and ill treatment. This should be realised by every body.

SOCIAL MANAGEMENT:-

Today in many countries every person has lost either his friend or relative because of AIDS. Now a days this disease is found in common the people in midst of us are infected by AIDS knowingly or unknowingly and they need sympathy from the society. But unfortunately they are receiving black marks and being scared of this patients are unwilling to go for blood check up and medication.

The organizations with volunteer service say that a cultured society instead of ill iterating a patient it should show sympathy forwards the patient and fill courage in him and help him in the best possible way. Every body should be facilitated to live a free life. When a patient has lost hopes in his life the society should allow him to participate in all the activities so as to make him gain interest to live with positive thinking. This may be a foundation for him to live happily till the end.

Take oath to obstruct AIDS-A Programme:-

In the world 14000 people are getting HIV infection daily. In India there are about 5 lakh infected more no of infected are found in 6 States (Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Manipur and Nagaland) and as Karnataka is one among them approximately 5 lakh people may have the infection.

Just as in the world and other parts of Asia even in our state AIDS is spreading rapidly as per the study of NACO from 2006-2008, there are 5 lakh people with HIV infection, while AIDS patients are 34.000 in number. The main reasons for this severe increase are company of prostitutes, reckless and unrestricted sexual contact, the practice of Devadasi, Poly gamy, child marriage, poverty, lack of education, gender, discrimination, lack of medical facilities, intake of drugs, the unrestricted of illegal sexual contacts of the heave transport vehicles. Due to the above all reasons, AIDS has spread rapidly throughout Karnataka.

Red Ribbon Express- Arrive to watch A pubic awareness programme by NACO:-

Karnataka is one among the 6 states of India which has a wide spread by HIV/AIDS and due to the lack of right information among the public these are many wrong assumptions about the infection. So in order to provide proper information about infection and the services available in the field, Rajiv Gandhi foundation had discovered the train by name " Red Ribbon Express" which started on 1st December 2007 travelled through different areas and reached Karnataka on 21st July then it travelled through out Karnataka for 27 days and successful in creating public ISSN 2231-5063 Volume-3, Issue-1, July-2013

Cold war against AIDS:-

Already there is a cold war being waged against HIV through self the world. In the early days as the doctors did not know the nature of the disease the way it spreads, they were helpless. But now there are changes in the circumstances expensive medicines to control the virus is found in the market. Now there is a plan to start the companies for the production of such medicines in India. It is declared that various programmes will be initiated through the Government and NGO s to train about the usage of medicines to the specialized doctors.

The autonomous organizations have covered the whole Karnataka by conducting urban and rural caring programmes and supportive programmes in all the districts the adverse effects of the disease is conveyed through street plays, Folk songs, hospital camps, Pamphlets and above all the patients are made to inform about the effects of the disease to the public. It could be said that though all the programmes are being done by the organizations the control seems to be very less.

CONCLUSIONS (SUGGESTIONS):

Compared to all the deadly disease such as plague, cholera, malasia seen by the world, AIDS is most dangerous. It is so deadly spread that a person is dying per hour. Many to control the disease which is seen since a decade. But the investment made is in vain. The so called developed countries such as America, Europe, Canada, have got a little control over the disease. In other countries the word AIDS sounds so harsh making the situation so terrible that the effective projects are not successful.

Through the government is spending crores together for the eradication of the disease the efforts are in vain. It is a mystry that all are getting attacked by the disease without knowing that it is the duty of the society too and not only Govt should bear the responsibility.
