#### **STATISTICAL ANALYSIS:**

To analyze the data, t-ratio were used to compared the study of socio-economic status of Kabaddi and Kho-Kho players.

#### **RESULTS AND DISCUSSION:**

The result of the present study are presented in Table 1

Table 1 reveals the socio-economic status of Kabaddi and Kho-Kho players obtained the mean values of 10.30 and 12.13 respectively. The obtained t=2.78 significant at 0.05 which means the significance difference as found out between Kabaddi and Kho-Kho players. It revealed that Kabaddi and Kho-Kho players had differ in socio-economic status in favour of Kabaddi players.

#### **CONCLUSION:**

There are significant differences in socio-economic status between Kabaddi and Kho-Kho players. The Kabaddi players have got more socio-economic status than Kho-Kho players.
