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ADJUSTMENT OF SCHOOL TEACHERS WITH REGARD TO TYPE OF INSTITUTION AND TEACHING EXPERIENCE

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Abstract:-The aim of this study was to find out the adjustment of school teachers with respect to type of institution and teaching experience. Survey method was conducted on a random sample of 200 school teachers in Chidambaram, Tamil Nadu. Data was analyzed by t-test and F-ratio. Result found that the level of adjustment of school teachers is average. Findings also showed that there is no significant difference in adjustment of school teachers based on type of institution and teaching experience.

INTRODUCTION:

The mean value lies between 58 and 37. Thus the adjustment of school teachers based on teaching experience is average.
