Treatment Two hand weedings at 20 and 40 DAS recorded significantly lowest weed density, followed by PoE application of treatment Propaquizafop 10% EC @ 100 g a.i./ha PoE but caused chlorosis in the sesame crop thus bad effect on yield parameters.
